- Open Singles and Doubles (Open to all) -- (3/5,2/3)
- Expert Singles and Doubles (0 à 1500) -- (2/3,2/3)
- Amateur Singles and Doubles (0 à 1000) -- (2/3, -race to 7-)
- Women Singles and Doubles -- (2/3, -race to 7-)
- Pro-Am * (Open to all) -- (2/3,2/3)
- Open Mixed Doubles Roto ** (Open to all) -- (2/3, -race to 7-)
- Double DYP *** (Open to all) -- (2/3,2/3)
- Goalie War (Open to all) (-race to 7- W & L sides)

Note:

All events will be Double Elimination (DKO), 2 out of 3 by 5 points on both winning and losing sides, EXCEPT FOR OPEN SINGLES AND DOUBLES EVENTS, where the winning side will be 3 out of 5 by 5 points. The format for Amateur Singles and Doubles, Mixed Doubles and Women Singles and Doubles includes a race to 7 points on the losing side.

* Pro-AM:

A Pro Elite or Pro Master can only play with an Amateur.

A Pro can only play with an Amateur or an Amateur Élite.

An Expert Élite can only play with an Expert, Amateur Élite or Amateur.

** Open Mixed Doubles Roto:

The team that scores a goal must switch positions. The players of the other team can switch positions if they want. Switching handles will be tolerated only during timeouts.

*** DYP = Draw your partner. Teams will be drawn at random regardless of the ranking. This event will not be counted in the official ranking system.

- We offer a flat cost of \$50 for all players who have never participated in a major tournament of the AQBB, and to all Amateurs (750 points or less). This includes a maximum of 8 events for the weekend. If someone wants to do more than 8 events, he/she will have to pay the current price for each additional event.
