

2016 Canadian Foosball Championship



We are pleased to officially announce the 2016 Bonzini Canadian Foosball Championship, from **Friday, September the 23rd, to Sunday, September the 25th, 2015**. This tournament will sanctioned by the AQBB and the ITSF. It will be held at the Loisirs Récréatifs et Communautaires de Rosemont (Centre Alphonse-Desjardins) in Montreal.

Open Singles and Doubles champions will keep the 2016 Canadian title for a year.

EVENTS FORMAT :

- Open Singles and Doubles (Open to everybody) -- (3/5,2/3)
- Expert Singles and Doubles (1000 to 1500 points) -- Singles (2/3,1/7) Doubles (2/3,2/3)
- Amateur Singles and Doubles (0 to 1000 points) -- (2/3,1/7)
- Women Singles (Open to everybody) -- (2/3,1/7)
- Mixed Doubles (Open to everybody) -- (2/3,2/3)
- Open DYP * (Open to everybody) -- (2/3,1/7)
- Beginner Doubles ** (0-750 points) -- (2/3,1/7)
- Pro-Am *** (Open to everybody) -- (2/3,2/3)
- Inactive Handicap Double s**** (Open to everybody) -- (SKO 2/3)

* DYP = Draw your partner :

Teams are chosen randomly. This event will not count in the official ranking.

** Beginner Doubles :

- For amateurs only (excluding amateur élite)
- Players should have never won an event sanctioned by the AQBB. The organization reserves the right to refuse a player to participate at this event.

*** Pro-Am :

A Pro Élite or Pro Master can only play with an Amateur.

A Pro can only play with an Amateur or an Amateur Elite.

An Expert Elite can only play with an Expert, Amateur Elite or Amateur.

**** Inactive Handicap Doubles:

An inactive player in the A.Q.B.B. ranking will be allowed to play with any active or inactive player.

The handicap will be determined by the average points of the team.

From 2001 points, the team should score 8 points to win a game.

From 1501 to 2000 points, the team should score 7 points to win a game.

From 1001 to 1500 points, the team should score 6 points to win a game.

From 501 to 1000 points, the team should score 5 points to win a game.

Less than 501 points, the team should score 4 points to win a game.

This event will not count in the official ranking.

DYP and Inactive Handicap Doubles fees are 10\$ per event per player. Beginner Doubles fees are 5\$.

- Table fees will be 5\$ per event up to a maximum of 25\$. No table fees will be charged to a player who only plays one event in Beginner, Amateur or Mixed.
- The players must have their ball during a match. Balls will be available at the cost of 3\$/ball.
- We offer a 50\$ package for any players who has never attended a tournament sanctioned by the AQBB and to all players with a ranking of 750 points and under. This package is for a maximum of 7 events. If a player wants to play in more than 7 events, he/she will have to pay for each additional event. The DYP can't be part of the package deal; must be bought separately.
- Handles will be purchasable for \$ 15 / handle. Players can also rent handles for \$ 2 / handle, ID will be retained by the organization until the players bring back the handles at the end of their tournament.
